## Welcome to NZO 2017 - Useful Information

### The venue;

Turn off Main South Road by the aeroplane into Harvard Ave. Entry is off Harvard Avenue, just before the Air Force Museum of New Zealand. Turn off Main South Road, just past the Sockburn overhead bridge. Look for a gateway into a paddock on your left, there will be signs at the gate. After entering the paddock turn right and you will see signs for car parking ahead. Please keep to our designated parking area, there are model aircraft grass runways over to the left side of the paddock and we don't want them damaged.

Some of our members will be on site Wednesday morning, if you arrive in Christchurch early you are welcome to join us, you might get a job though.

While it may not be noticeable Wigram is still run by the Air Force and there are certain aspects of our being on their grounds that are important to them. Unless

specifically invited, the only building that we have access to is the small toilet block behind hanger No2. All other buildings other than the public area in the Museum itself are out of bounds and not to be entered. Dogs are not allowed at Wigram, the grassed area is used for a variety of events and often children are involved. Please respect these requirements.

**Security;**

Graham Ingall will be staying on site Thursday to Saturday nights to provide additional security and the paddock gate will be locked. We will endeavour to store as many Karts as we can under cover, other than that they will be in the open if left on site.

**On site food;**

Our club will be providing reasonably priced lunch and drinks on site Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

**Spare parts;**

New Blokart parts will be available via our member and blokart dealer Graeme Gordon. Our club can supply Blokart tyres, tubes and free running bearings, see Trevor French.
